

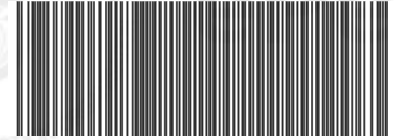

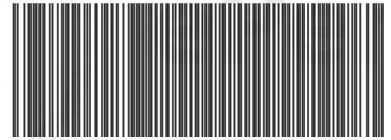

ORGANIC GROWING MEDIA, SPHAGNUM MOSS, MOSS AND PEAT

1. Additional declaration on the Phytosanitary Certificate that-
 - 1.1 the consignment was inspected and found free from live insects, seeds and soil .
 - 1.2. a laboratory test has demonstrated freedom from -
 - (a) Fungal pathogens
 - (b) Bacterial pathogens; and
 - (c) Plant parasitic nematodes

- (a) The consignment was irradiated at a minimum absorbed dosage of 50 kGy.

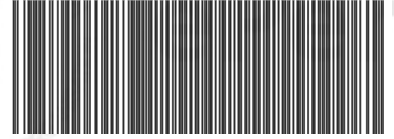
